How do I use scissors correctly?

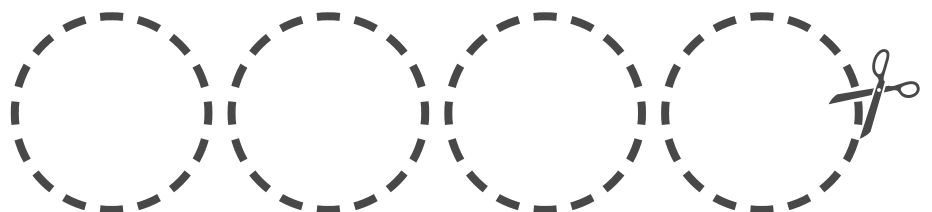
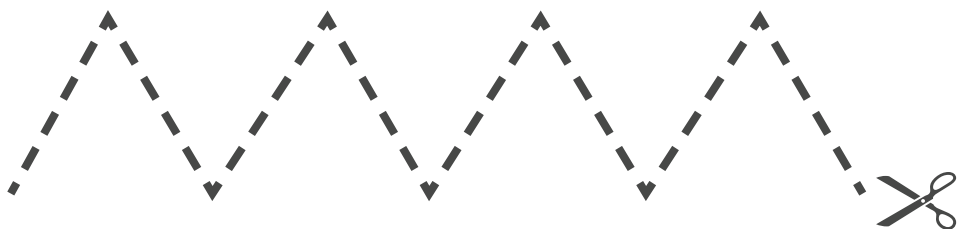
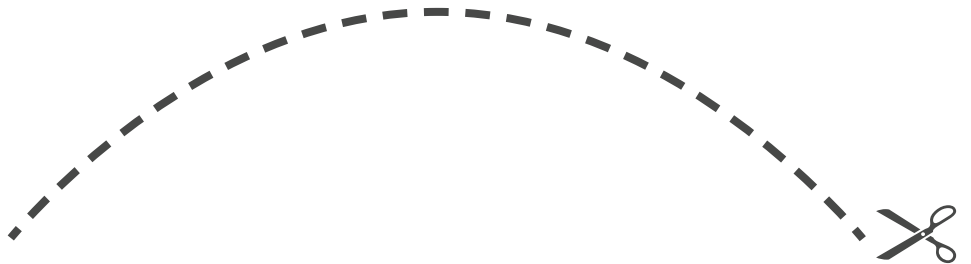
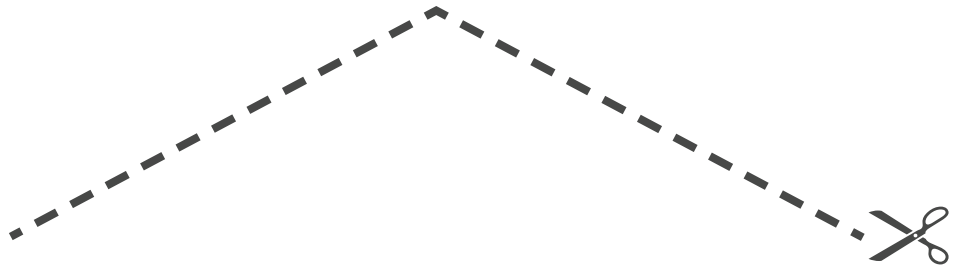
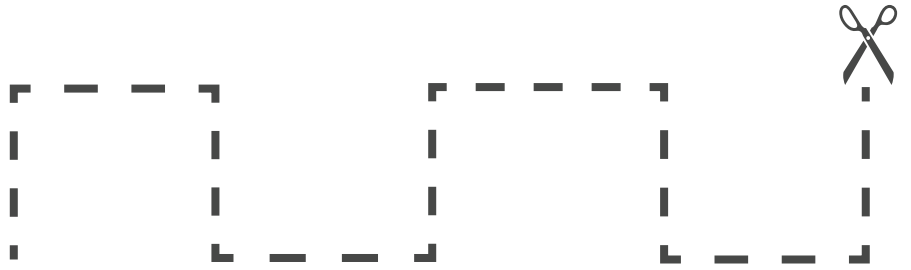
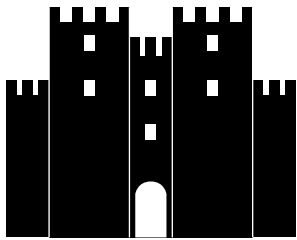
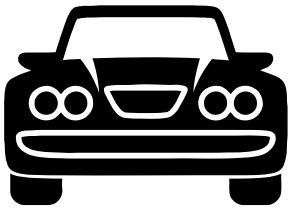
1. When I carry scissors, I always keep them closed and hide the metal end in my fist.
2. My thumb goes in the upper grip hole, my index and middle finger go in the lower grip hole. If I'm using scissors with smaller grip holes, I place my index finger along the outside of the grip hole instead of inserting it.
3. I cut slowly and along the line.
4. I turn the paper, not the scissors.



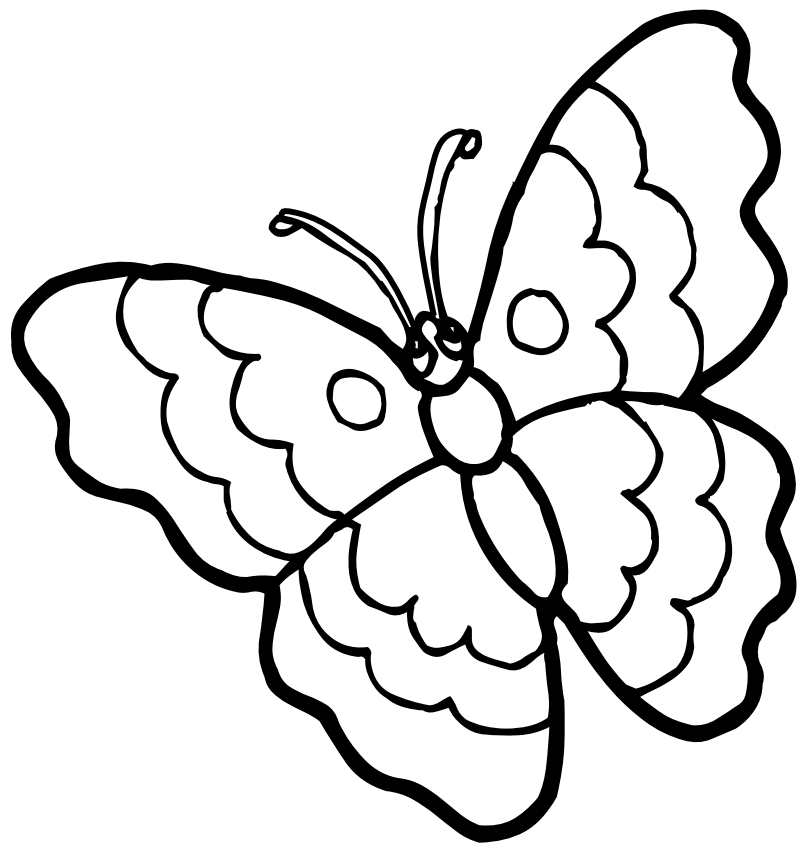

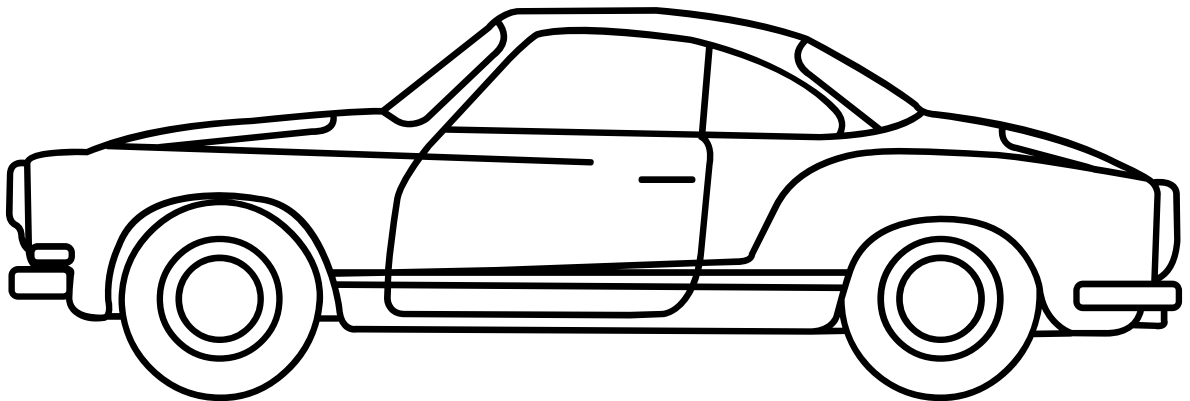
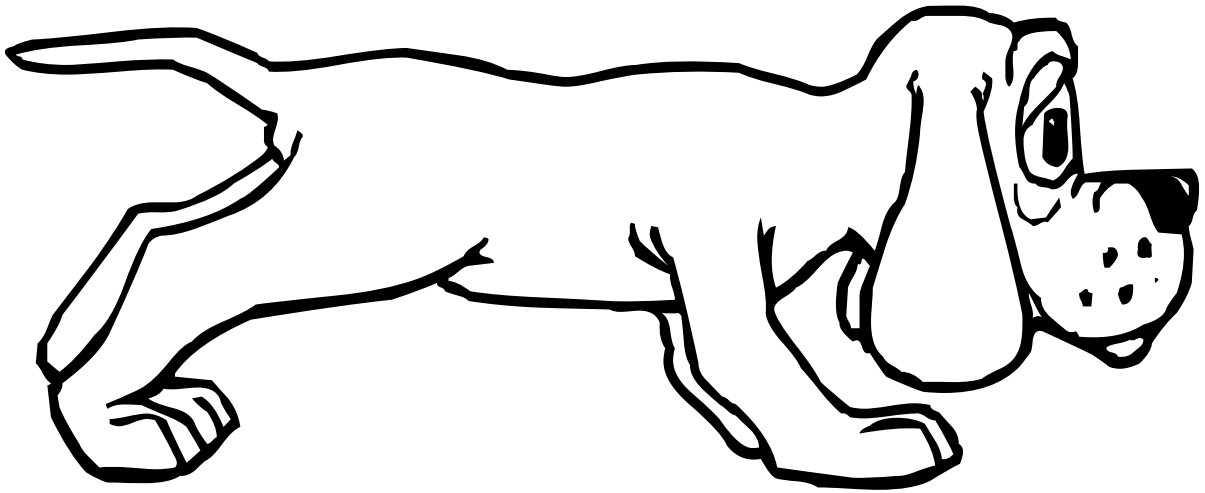
